



## Gates open for scrutiny at 3pm

All vehicles must be presented for scrutiny as follows:

Date: Friday 24th July 2009  
Location: Number 3 Oval, Mildura  
Time: 5:00pm until 9:00pm

Note: All competitors upon completion of scrutiny are required to leave their vehicles at the venue until 9:00pm for public viewing.

We ask for your co-operation on attending Scrutiny and leaving your vehicles on display, as we want Sunraysia residents to see these immaculately prepared vehicles and teams.

All competitors are reminded that all apparel including footwear and helmets must be presented for checking at scrutiny.

### 9.2 Documentation

The following documentation will be checked prior to scrutiny CAMS Off Road Competition licences, CAMS Pass Books, civil driving licences, CAMS vehicle log books, current CAMS-affiliated club membership cards, and Competitor (if not the driver) licences (if applicable).

Nominations for the AORC Tri-Series shall be made by close of documentation.

Refer to Article 13.4 of the 2009 Australian Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations.

Vehicle Log Books will be held by the Chief Scrutineer after scrutiny and are to be signed for and collected from Event Headquarters at the completion of Sunday's event.

## 10. CREW BRIEFINGS

Refer Article 7 of the 2009 Australian Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations.

Briefings for competing crew will be conducted on:

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009 at 7:45am prior to the Prologue

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009 at 12:15pm prior to Section 1

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2009 at 8:30am prior to Section 2

Briefings will take place at Event Headquarters. Sign on sheets will be available from 20 minutes prior to each briefing.

Attendance at each crew briefing by each entered crew member is compulsory, and each competing crew member is required to sign on. Cases of non-attendance will be referred to the stewards by way of a formal charge, which may result in a penalty.

## 11. RUNNING DETAILS

### 11.1 General

The venue for the event will be Tapio Station, Arumpo Road, Buronga NSW.



The event will consist of 4 laps of the 125 kilometre circuit, the surface of which is dirt, sand, gravel, clay, grass and mallee scrub.

The event will be conducted in 2 sections The total competitive distance will be 500km.

Section 1 will consist of 1 – 125klm lap on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

Section 2 will consist of 1 – 125klm lap a ½ hour service break, 1 – 125klm lap ½ hour service break, then 1 – 125klm lap on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

Section 1 of the PWR Sunraysia 500 will start at 1:00pm on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

Section 2 of the PWR Sunraysia 500 will start at 9:00am on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

On Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July, vehicles must be lined up in their starting order in the marshalling area prior to the start time of the briefing.

Time out cards will be issued after Section 2 Lap 1 and Section 2 Lap 2. It is the competitor's responsibility to be in the dummy grid area prior to their due time out.

Vehicles will start at 1 minute intervals for Section 1 Lap 1. The start interval for Section 2 Lap 1 will be advised at briefing on Sunday morning.

There will be opportunity for competing crew to enter the pits at approximately the 55km point of each lap as the track returns close to the pits. This can be done via the designated entry and exit from the course proper. Competitors may carry out repairs in the pits in their own time. No addition of fuel to the vehicle is permitted.

### **11.7 Restarting**

Competitors not completing Section 1 may make application to the Clerk of Course to start Section 2. Application to start in Section 2 must be made by 4:00pm on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

### **11.8 Allowed Time**

To be classified as a finisher, a crew shall complete a section within the time allowed as follows:

Section 1: one hour and forty minutes (100minutes)

Section 2: five hours (300minutes)
